We welcome any and all people to take part in the ***Sunday Worship Gathering*** activities, ***School of Theology, Community Outreach***, and ***Area Missional Communities***. The difference is that we have expectations for those who want to be part of our partnering membership.

Membership Information

The following information is provided for you to understand the membership process here at Renovo Church.

Why Partnering Membership?

Officially becoming a partnering member of a local church is an important step for each believer. The Bible teaches that we are already members “one with the other” because of our spiritual union with Jesus Christ. In this sense, we are already all part of that great body of individuals who have come to salvation through personal faith in God’s Son. It is clear from the New Testament, however, that God’s design is for each Christian to also be an accountable part of an organized, local group of believers who assemble under the pastoral oversight of elders. The loving, mutual service, which results among the people of God, is His means of presenting Christ to the watching world, and is also one essential way for us to show love for God. As times change, cultures change as well, and often the surrounding society strongly impacts the Church. We live today in an age of increasing demand for privacy, individuals “rights,” and self-fulfillment. Sadly, we often find the same attitudes present in those who profess to follow Jesus Christ, and this has negatively affected both the church’s power and witness.

Am I Ready?

In general, partnership at RENOVO is extended to all believers who:

1. **Submit in the questionnaire** and written testimony of one’s personal faith in Jesus Christ as Savior to the Renovo Leadership.
2. **Desire** to live a life separated from sinful habits of the flesh and worldliness.
3. **Evidence** a burden for those without Jesus Christ as Savior and desire to be used to share the Gospel.
4. Are in **agreement** with the Statement of Faith and the Constitution and By-Laws of this Church.
5. Have been **baptized** as a believer. The mode practiced by this church shall be immersion.
6. Demonstrate **commitment** to each other and to God by giving one’s time, talents, and financial support to the ministry of the Church.
7. **Meet with the Leadership** of Renovo Church thereof to be examined in the above areas and upon unanimous approval of the leadership to be received into membership.

Where Do I Begin?

Meet with Renovo Leaders

This interview allows the ministers and leaders to meet you, confirm your testimony, and answer any questions you may have about RENOVO, or your role in the mission of this church. Applicants who satisfy the requirements outlined above are then recommended for membership.

We realize that people come to RENOVO with different levels of spiritual maturity and understanding. It is our goal to help each one of you mature in your discipleship to Jesus Christ. Pursuing membership affords us an excellent opportunity to provide that guidance, and we commend you for your interest in this step of obedience.

RENOVO STRUCTURE OF LEADERSHIP

Christ Is the Senior Pastor

The Apostle Paul instructed those in Ephesus (Ephesians 1:22-23) that Jesus is the head of the church, which is his body. There is only one senior pastor for the Church, one who is ultimately head over it all -- Jesus Christ. Under his leadership, he has given some to the church to be apostles, prophets, and evangelists and some to be pastors and teachers to equip God's people for works of service (Ephesians 4:11-12). It is not the job of the leadership of the church to do all the ministry. Instead, they are called to teach, prepare, and send the

people of God out to be the ministers who serve God, the body, and the world through their own unique talents, gifts, and passions.

Eldership & Pastoral Staff

el•der (el'der) n. 1. Elected or appointed governing officer within a church (*See 1 Timothy 3: 1-7, Titus 1: 6-9*). The elders (“pastors”) of Renovo Church shall be appointed by the congregation through God to shepherd and lead the flock of Renovo Church. It is our desire to lead this Church through this culture in a way pleasing to the Lord. Leading is not always easy or pleasurable, but as God continues to work through the elders by washing his children with His word the Lord is presenting himself a radiant Church. The Renovo Church elders shall convene regularly to discuss matters of sound theology, direction for the Church, and discipline with love for the people at Renovo Church. The elders wish to preach, teach, and counsel to the glory of God, and these matters are not taken lightly. Renovo Church deacons help the elders, enabling them to do what God has commanded. The elders desire that we would be a Church that strives to live in accordance to the Bible and enjoy all that God has given to his people.

Deacons

dea•con (de'ken) n. 1. Attendant or assistant to church leaders (*See 1 Timothy 3: 8*) Historically, deacons have served as both care providers and overseers of the church body. Everyone on staff at Renovo Church is considered a leader of the church: an elder (very few), a deacon, or a deacon-in-training. In addition, there are deacons who serve in a non-staff capacity, as well as other volunteers and interns whom Renovo Church depends on to be the hands and feet of our Church, the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:2).

About God ...

There is only one true God. He is the Creator of all life and the Supreme Ruler of the universe. The Holy Spirit is co-equal with God the Father and God the Son. He dwells in each member of God's family as a Helper and Guide. He provides help to every Christian to do what is right, strength to serve Jesus, and direction for living life God's way. Every Christian is to allow God's Spirit to help him on a daily basis.

About Man ...

We are created in the spiritual likeness or image of God. About the Bible ...

About Salvation ...

We need salvation because we have sinned. Sin separates us from God who desires relationship with us. It is impossible for any man to restore that broken relationship with God by any amount of personal goodness, religious deeds, or by belonging to a church. We cannot earn, merit or achieve a right relationship with God by our own efforts. The death of Jesus was not an accident. It was God's plan from the beginning to save us from our sins through the death of Jesus Christ. The Bible calls God's act of love, grace. His grace is His gift to us. The way we receive His gift is by entering into a covenant relationship with Jesus by placing our belief and faith in Him. When we turn from our self-ruled life and turn to Jesus in faith, we are saved. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his life by faith; this is done through the process of Belief, Confession, Repentance, Baptism, and Receiving the Gift of the Holy Spirit. Salvation is God's free gift to us but we must accept it. We can never make up for our sin by self-improvement or good works. Only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness, can anyone be saved from sin's penalty.

About the Church ...

The Church is God's spiritual family. It is made up of all those who have chosen to place their trust and faith in Jesus and who are His followers (disciples). The Church is not a building or one particular group of believers. To belong to the Church, is to belong to Jesus. The Bible uses the analogy that Jesus is the Head of the Church, which is His body. God's will is for the Church to gather regularly to worship its Head, Jesus, to use its various gifts and abilities to serve its Head, to love and encourage those who are in the body, and to work diligently to maintain the unity of the body. As the members of His Church love one another and maintain unity of purpose and relationship, the world around us will recognize that we belong to Jesus. The Church or body is to seek to do the will of God, which also includes loving and saving the world through Jesus Christ.

PLANTING... truth through conversations and questions to express God's full story of grace (John 2:1-11).

REAPING... a life changing harvest by extending Christ's challenge to repent, believe, and be baptized (John 13:12-17).

With training programs and various resources, Renovo Church shall support other prospective and existing church plants. Renovo Church is directly affiliated with the Campbell/Stone Restoration.

What does a candidate for missions look like?

VISIONaries... these ministers understand and communicate clearly and concisely theology, philosophy of ministry, Jesus' strategy of the Church.

COACHing... ministers are able to teach, preach and train existing disciples, ministers and missionaries effectively.

REPRODUCING... able to mentor and lead others through the rhythms, identities, and ethos of the story of God and mankind.

Missionaries are sent by God (like Jesus) into our culture to restore all things to a right relationship with God. We live actively as missionaries for the sake of others and God's glory.

SESSION #4:
HOW DOES RENOVO CHURCH EMBODY
IT'S MISSION?
(OUR EXPECTATIONS OF A PARTNERING MEMBER)

The description of a disciplined person in our ministry.

1) Believer:

- To learn more about the nature and story of God.
- To become knowledgeable in the history and heritage of the Kingdom of God.
- To become better trained and equipped to serve in the Kingdom of God.
- Growing stronger in Faith by practicing spiritual habits.

2) Confessor

- Living a lifestyle of communication to the world that Jesus Christ is the Risen Lord and Son of God.
- Communicating to God the daily battle of life and relying on his intervention in matters of struggles.
- Partnering with others to share in sin, abuse, addictions, temptations, conflict management, etc.

3) Baptizer

- To live out a lifestyle that is to pick up our cross daily and dying with him.
- Being united with Christ in Baptism (Romans 6).
- Going into all the world and making disciples, and baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

4) Repenter

- Daily making the decision to not sin.
- Finding tools and disciplines that will allow individual to stay away from self destructive behavior.
- Leaving the old habits that were part of the world.

5) Inspirer

- Allowing the Holy spirit to lead and guide in love.
- To motivate and commission the lost, other disciples, ministers and missionaries to live and walk closer to the all mighty God.
- Spurring others onto good works so that God maybe glorified.

6) Prayer

- Committing to a constant prayer life.
- Bringing all requests and concerns before the creator.
- Becoming better equipped in ways and means of meditation with God.

7) Discipler

- Building up and encouraging others. Finding the lost and sharing the good news with them. Encourage them to Believe in Christ, Confess Him as the Lord, Repent of Sin, Become united with Him on the Cross having their sins washed away through baptism (immersion), being filled with the Holy spirit, because of a clear conscience before God.
- To take fellow disciples and training them in spending time with God, expecting them to be accountable to God & the body, pushing to memorize the scripture of God, to be involved with the Church, to give back sacrificially to God, time and income, to study scriptures diligently so that they might know and understand God fully, and to fast regularly so that God might help us to depend on him rather than the vices of this world.
- To take other ministers and help them to discover their gifts and talents to use for the Kingdom.

8) Server

- Eagerly serving others with a W3 mindset: Whatever, Whenever, Wherever.
- Submitting to leadership with joyful hearts.
- To become the least in our community. So that God might use the disciple as his manifestation on earth, model to others that we love them.

9) Giver

- Committing to meeting with the whole congregation on our Sunday morning Gatherings.
- Giving tithes and offerings to the work of the local congregation, it's ministries, and missions.
- Looking for opportunities to help others I need, responding to the needs in an appropriate sacrificial manner.
